They're on the run and on the road. They've been around the globe a couple of times through Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Germany, France, Finland, Italy, Norway, Sweden, Holland, Spain, Slovenia, Hungary, UK and the Czech Republic, USA, Canada and Japan. Playing over 400 shows in the last three years.

**The Peacocks** have sold thousands of albums in their 16 year career on their European label, Leech Records, Household Name Records, Crazy Love and Elmo Records; Asian Man Records, Jump Up and Hairball 8 Records in North America; and TV Freak in Japan. They've kicked everybody's ass from Bad Religion, No Means No, Rancid, No FX, Toasters, Demented Are Go...But they're still hungry (even though their backs hurt' cause floors suck to sleep on). So, after consuming too much coffee and cigarettes, they continue

to tour like crazy and win over hearts everywhere with their explosive stand up bass driving sound. Punk, Rockabilly, great songs, cool beats, pop but good. They're moving on and up. Probably one day with nice shirts. And with a new old van. Pedal to the metal!

#### **Biography:**

**1990:** First show

**1993:** Hasu Langhart (guitar and vocals), Simon Langhard (upright bass) and Adi Langhart (drums) release their first 4-song single „Red Sun“. The song „My Generation“ ends up Number 8 in the national radio airplay charts

**1995:** Release their first album „Come With Us“

**1996:** Adi quits the band cause of his job. For the USA/Canada tour he is replaced by David Langhard (aka Admiral James T.)

**1997:** Toni Hilber joins as the new drummer

**1998:** Second album „In Without Knockin“ sells over 8000 copies

**1999-2001:** Play more than 300 shows in Europe, Canada, USA and Japan

**2001:** Their album „Angel“ is released by Asian Man Records. The single „Anger And Demand“ is a no. 1 hit in the Japanese indie-charts.

**2002:** Toni quits the band to have more time and money for his family. He is replaced by Jürg Luder

**2004:** „It's Time For“ recorded with Mass Giorgini, released on Leech Records and Crazy Love (mainland Europe), Household Name Records (UK), Asian Man Records (North America) and TV Freak Records (Japan).

**2004-2006:** Over 300 shows all over Europe, UK, Canada, USA and Japan

**2006:** US best-of released on Hairball 8 Records, followed by a US tour

**2007:** new album planned!
